Prayer Focus – 2026 – 5786

Theme Verses

Luke 4:1a – AMP – “Now Jesus, full of [and in perfect communication with] the Holy Spirit,”

John 3:34 – TPT – “The One whom God has sent to represent him will speak the words of God, because God has poured out upon him the fullness of the Holy Spirit without limitation.”

Voice – “The One sent from God speaks with the very words of God and abounds with the very Spirit and essence of God.”

John 14:30 – Message – “But don’t worry—he has nothing on me, no claim on me. But so the world might know how thoroughly I love the Father, I am carrying out my Father’s instructions right down to the last detail.”

Voice – “I am almost finished speaking to you. The one who rules the world is stepping forward, and he has no part in Me”

AMPC – “I will not talk with you much more, for the prince (evil genius, ruler) of the world is coming. And he has no claim on Me. [He has nothing in common with Me; there is nothing in Me that belongs to him, and he has no power over Me.]”

The refining of the Ekklesia and the Rise of the Remnant Warrior Bride

Jeremiah 18:1-6 – Holy Spirit will invite us to go DOWN to the Potter’s House with Him to be made into the vessel that God wants us to be.

Revelation 4:1 – “In 2026 doors in the spirit will continue to open for us to GO UP and rule and reign with King Jesus

I Peter 5:6 – TPT – “<sup>6</sup>If you bow low in God’s awesome presence, he will eventually exalt you as you leave the timing in his hands.”

Four ministries that represent moves of Holy Spirit in past seasons will continue to be raised up on 2026

4. Bishop Bill Hamon – The Saints Movement and the raising up of the saints to do the work of the ministry

A season when the spiritual dots connect and Holy Spirit gives understanding how to bring what He has been doing in our lives in past seasons into the present so we can embrace the new and build on previous revelations

Exposure of foundations

Tragically, many Christians will uproot and begin to drift and roam; so get radically anchored in your relationship with God, your local church and build strong Holy Ghost connections

Embrace the “stretchings” of Holy Spirit

Isaiah 54:1, 2, 3

Without pegs a tent cannot expand properly or remain rooted and stable. We are being called to stretch to make room for what God wants to do in 2026.

A righteous turning back to the basics (foundations) of Biblical Christianity

II Timothy 3:15-17 – “And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: <sup>17</sup> That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.”

The Bible (graphe) will empower us to live out our Christianity daily. This is a life of Bible study, prayer, fasting, repentance, forgiveness, faith, tithing, confession, faithful church attendance, praise, worship, etc.

A pandemic? An economic crash? A breaking of America’s financial foundation? A war that impacts America directly? Much more of the anti-Christ (Jesus) spirit

**Prayer Focus – My Church family – Shekinah Revival Ministries**

1. The number one assignment of Shekinah Revival Ministries is to host the Glory of God, to be a House of Presence (Shekinah)

Exodus 33:9, 10, 14, 15 – “And it came to pass, as Moses entered into the tabernacle, the cloudy pillar descended, and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and the Lord talked with Moses. <sup>10</sup> And all the people saw the cloudy pillar stand at the tabernacle door: and all the people rose up and worshipped, every man in his tent door.<sup>14</sup> And he said, My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest. <sup>15</sup> And he said unto him, If thy presence go not with me, carry us not up hence.”

2. King Jesus, WE are Your worshippers

II Chronicles 5:13, 14, “It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD; <sup>14</sup> So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.”

Our psalmists, minstrels, and dancers as they lead us in the ongoing rebuilding of the Tabernacle of David, prophetic praise and worship

Our ministry of intercession as our intercessions with petitions, prophetic and apostolic declarations pull down strongholds and open the Heavens over Shekinah Revival Ministries

#### 4. My spiritual family

I Corinthians 12:12, 13a – TLB – “Our bodies have many parts, but the many parts make up only one body when they are all put together. So it is with the “body” of Christ. <sup>13</sup> Each of us is a part of the one body of Christ.”

I Corinthians 12:25, 26 – Message – “The way God designed our bodies is a model for understanding our lives together as a church: every part dependent on every other part, the parts we mention and the parts we don’t, the parts we see and the parts we don’t. If one part hurts, every other part is involved in the hurt, and in the healing. If one part flourishes, every other part enters into the exuberance.”

Acts 2:8 – “But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.”

Mark 16:15-18 – “And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. <sup>16</sup> He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. <sup>17</sup> And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; <sup>18</sup> They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. <sup>19</sup> So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. <sup>20</sup> And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.”

- I. My personal relationship with the Lord

The ONE THING Principle

Psalm 27:4 – TPT – “Here’s the one thing I crave from Yahweh, the one thing I seek above all else: I want to live with him every moment in his house, beholding the marvelous beauty of Yahweh, filled with awe, delighting in his glory and grace. I want to contemplate in his temple.”

Increased hunger and thirst for God

Matthew 5:6

KJV – “Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.”

MSG – “You’re blessed when you’ve worked up a good appetite for God. He’s food and drink in the best meal you’ll ever eat.”

Psalm 42:2 – TPT – “My soul thirsts, pants, and longs for the living God. I want to come and see the face of God.”

Increased hunger and love for God’s Word

Psalm 119:47 – TPT – “My passion and delight is in your word, for I love what you say to me!”

Psalm 119:72 – TPT – “The words you speak to me are worth more than all the riches and wealth in the whole world!”

Psalm 119:107 – TPT – “I’m bruised and broken, overwhelmed by it all; breathe life into me again by your living word.”

Psalm 119:140 – TPT – “All your promises glow with fire; that’s why I’m a lover of your Word.”

Jeremiah 15:16a – KJV – “Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart”

Increased love and passion for God’s presence (the glory the Shekinah); fellowship with the Lord, my personal altar

Exodus 33:14, 15 – Voice – “**Eternal One:** <sup>14</sup> My presence will travel with you, and I will give you rest.

**Moses:** <sup>15</sup> If Your presence doesn’t travel with me, then don’t lead us away from here.”

James 4:8a

Voice – “Come close to the one true God, and He will draw close to you.”

TPT – “Move your heart closer and closer to God, and he will come even closer to you.”

That I am disciplined and diligent to maintain a strong born-again human spirit; spiritual strength

Proverbs 18:14 – KJV – “The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity; but a wounded spirit who can bear?

Isaiah 40:31 – MSG – “But those who wait upon GOD get fresh strength.

They spread their wings and soar like eagles, They run and don't get tired, they walk and don't lag behind.”

I Corinthians 14:4 – “Those who speak in an unknown language strengthen themselves.”

Jude 20 – “But you my friends, must progressively fortify yourselves in your most holy faith by praying in the Holy Ghost.”

## King Jesus, I am Your Worshipper

Psalm 95:6 – Voice – “Come, let us worship Him. Everyone bow down; kneel before the Eternal who made us.”

Psalm 96:9 – TPT – “Come worship the Lord God wearing the splendor of holiness. Let everyone wait in wonder as they tremble in awe before him.”

Revelation 4:10, 11 – TPT – “the twenty-four elders fell facedown before the one seated on the throne and they worshiped the one who lives forever and ever. And they surrendered their crowns before the throne, singing: <sup>11</sup> “You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory, honor, and power, for you created all things, and for your pleasure they were created and exist.”

## II. My personal family, our relationship with the Lord and each other

### The husband/wife relationship, the family – father, mother, children, grandchildren, etc.

Acts 16:31 – TPT – “They answered, “Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved—you and all your family.”

Ephesians 5:22, 25, 28 – “Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

<sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; <sup>28</sup> So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.”

Ephesians 6:1, 2 – “Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. <sup>2</sup> Honor thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise”

Psalm 127:3-5 – TPT – “Children are God's love-gift; they are heaven's generous reward. <sup>4</sup> Children born to a young couple will one day rise to protect and provide for their parents. <sup>5</sup> Happy will be the couple who has many of them! A household full of children will not bring shame on your name but victory when you face your enemies, for your offspring will have influence and honor to prevail on your behalf!”

Deuteronomy 11:18-21 – “Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. <sup>19</sup> And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. <sup>20</sup> And thou shalt write them upon the door posts of thine house, and upon thy gates:

<sup>21</sup> That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth.”

Proverbs 7:6 – TPT – “Grandparents have the crowning glory of life: grandchildren! And it's only proper for children to take pride in their parents.”

WHAT – a twenty-one day Daniel Fast

WHEN – Friday, January 2 – Thursday, January 22, 2026

There are several types of fasting found in the Scriptures; everything from a partial, one-day fast to a 40 day full fast.

Holy Spirit has directed me to call Shekinah Revival Ministries to a 21-day Daniel Fast with a few additions and instructions.

Food guidelines for a Daniel Fast

Daniel 1:8a, 12b – ”But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank, <sup>12</sup>give us pulse to eat, and water to drink.”

Daniel 10:2, 3 – “In those days I Daniel was mourning three full weeks. <sup>3</sup>I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.”

In addition to eating according to the guidelines of a Daniel Fast, Holy Spirit impressed me to have us consider Sunday and/or Wednesday as water only fasting days.

Effective fasting is Holy Spirit led fasting and praying and fasting with specific purpose and focus.

The three weeks will be divided into three one-week time periods.

Week #1 – Friday, January 2 – Thursday, January 8

Prayer Focus - My personal and my family's relationship with the Lord

Week #2 – Friday, January 9 – Thursday, January 15

Prayer Focus – My church family at Shekinah Revival Ministries

Week #3 – Friday, January 16 – Thursday, January 22

Prayer Focus – 5786 – 2026

## Suggestions

1. Let this be a Spirit-led, non-legalistic, non-competitive fast.
2. Allow Holy Spirit to “stretch” you as you follow His fasting instructions for you.
3. Spend extra time in Bible reading, meditation, praise, worship, and prayer, both privately and corporately.
4. For encouragement and strength, read the fasting scriptures and books about fasting and prayer.
5. Consider keeping a journal during the twenty-one days.
6. Each morning, sanctify the day by washing your face and anointing yourself with oil. Matthew 6:17
7. Parents – coach your children as to their involvement.
8. It is recommended that you drink up to one-half of your body weight in ounces of water each day.
9. If you are under a physician’s care and/or are taking medicine, you may consider consulting your physician before fasting.
