Winning the War of Words

February 9 – March 1, 2026

James 3:8

Translations

TPT – “but the tongue is not able to be tamed. It’s a fickle, unrestrained evil that spews out words full of toxic poison!”

Voice – “But no man has ever demonstrated the ability to tame his own tongue! It is a spring of restless evil, brimming with toxic poisons.”

There is only ONE way the human tongue can be subdued and tamed; we need God’s help. The tongue must be brought under the control and power of Holy Spirit

Spiritual Law – In the span of a lifetime, God gives to every person turning point opportunities (defining moments). These are times when Holy Spirit moves on a person's heart and opens a season and offers change. In this season there is an opportunity to have a God-encounter that have the potential to change a life forever (an individual, a family, a church, a nation, etc.)

Isaiah's turning point time

Vs. 1 translation - "In the year that King Uzziah died, then it was that I ALSO saw the Lord"

How Isaiah saw the Lord – THE UPWARD LOOK

"Lord" – Adonai – the owner, the sovereign one, ruler, master, controller

"sitting" – Hebrew – "yasheb" – a posture that implies one who is not moved, settled, remaining, abiding, not nervous, no fear

"throne" – Hebrew – "kikkeh" – a seat of a king, a canopied seat or chair with back and arms which speaks of justice, rule, government, majesty, worship, and presence

Vs. 5 – How Isaiah saw himself, THE INWARD LOOK

“woe is me” – in the sense of crying out, a lamentation, alas, overwhelming sorrow and grief

“undone” – Hebrew – “damah” – to be cut down, to be brought to silence, to be disqualified, to be out of place

“a man of unclean lips”

-“unclean” – Hebrew – “tame” – foul, polluted, contaminated, defiled

-now I know what's wrong, now I know what's holding me (us) back; it's not the devil, demons, not.....It's my mouth that's holding me (us) back. My (our) words are holding us back. “For mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts”

Spiritual Law – Seeing the Lord right precedes seeing oneself right

Vs. 6, 7 – Heaven's fire on Isaiah's
lips

Vs. 8, 9 – From disqualified to
qualified, THE OUTWARD LOOK

My declaration – I declare that Holy Spirit is helping me to steward well this Twenty-one Day Fast. I declare that this is a turning point season for me. Therefore, I am seizing every opportunity that is being made available to me and believing for impartation from Holy Spirit that will change my life forever. As it was with the Prophet Isaiah, I declare a God-encounter with the Fire of God from the altar of Heaven. Father, I ask, “Please touch my lips with Heaven’s Fire and I will never be the same again.” In the name of the risen, exalted, warrior, King Jesus! Amen!
